Nebraska Association of Resources Districts Nomination Form – Director of the Year

The Nebraska Association of Resources Districts (NARD) sponsors an annual Director Award to:

- Recognize outstanding effort and dedication to conservation, aiming toward NRD goals.
- Promote NRDs, conservation, natural resources and other environmental issues
- Reward attendance at NRD committee, board and other meetings
- Recognize insight into legislation, current issues and stewardship of the land

Criteria

- 1. Nominee must be a current or past Natural Resources District Director.
- 2. Demonstration of sincere interest and dedication to natural resources conservation must have been exhibited.
- 3. Innovative and leadership qualities must have been demonstrated.
- 4. Demonstration of professional growth and/or affiliations.
- 5. Directors must have shown desire to educate the general public about NRD activities and conservation efforts.
- 6. Nominee must have demonstrated regular attendance at local NRD board meetings and functions.
- 7. One award will be presented each year at the NARD Annual Meeting.

Nominations

- 1. Nominations must include:
 - a. Nominee name, address, telephone number
 - b. Submitting NRD name, address and telephone number
- 2. A description of the activities and accomplishments of the nominee.
- 3. Nominations must not exceed **two** typed, double-spaced pages. Supplemental information, e.g. newspaper articles, photographs, etc., may be added.

Procedure

- 1. Qualified nominations must be submitted by a local NRD Manager.
- 2. Nominations must be received by **May** at the NARD office, 601 S 12th Street, Suite 201, Lincoln, NE 68508.
- 3. The NARD Executive Committee will serve as the Selection Committee.
- 4. The recipient will be recognized at the NARD Annual Conference.
- 5. The NARD President or his/her designee will present the award.
- 6. Local NRD will make arrangements for award winner to be present at the NARD Annual Meeting for award presentation.
