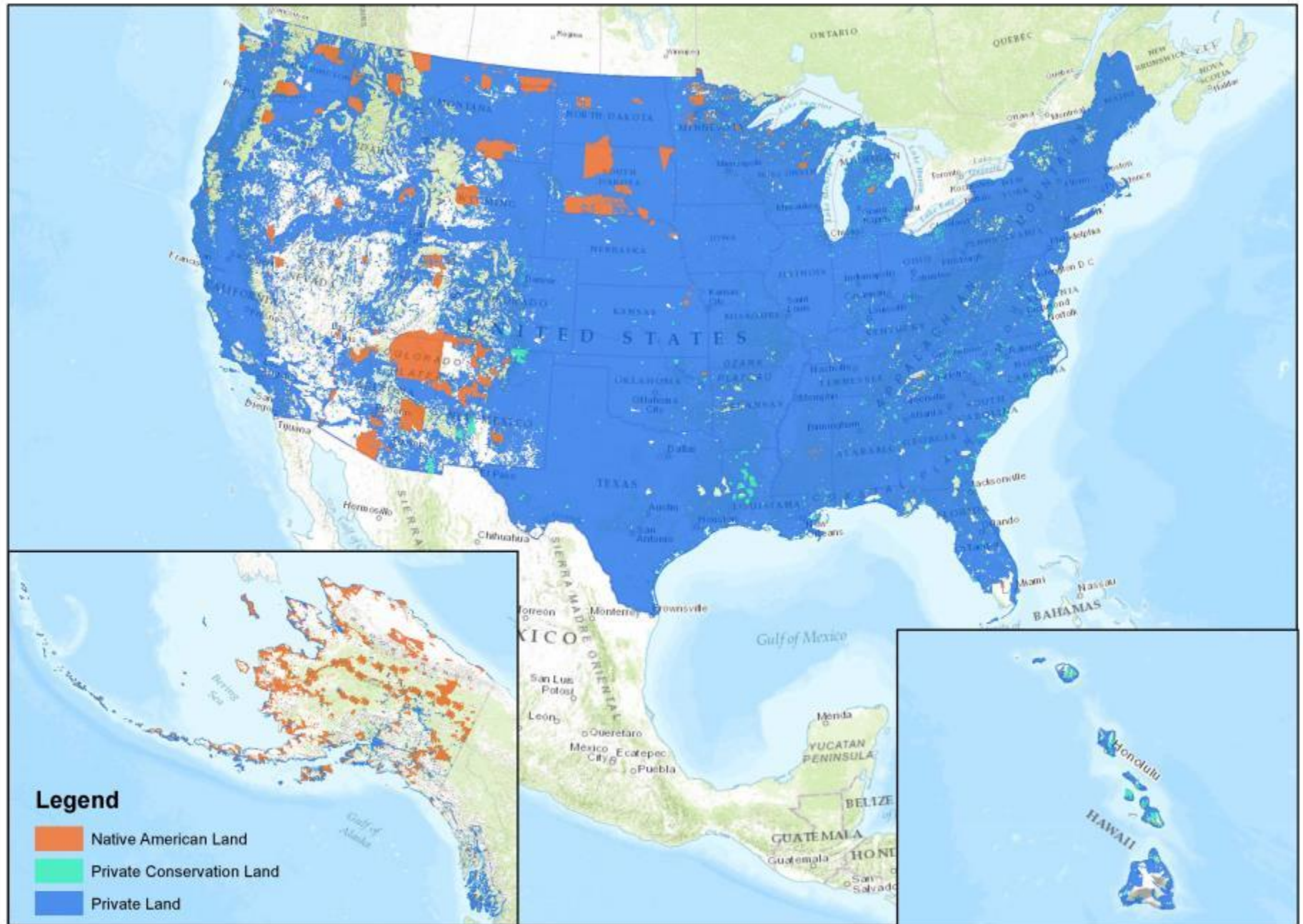

U.S. Land Ownership

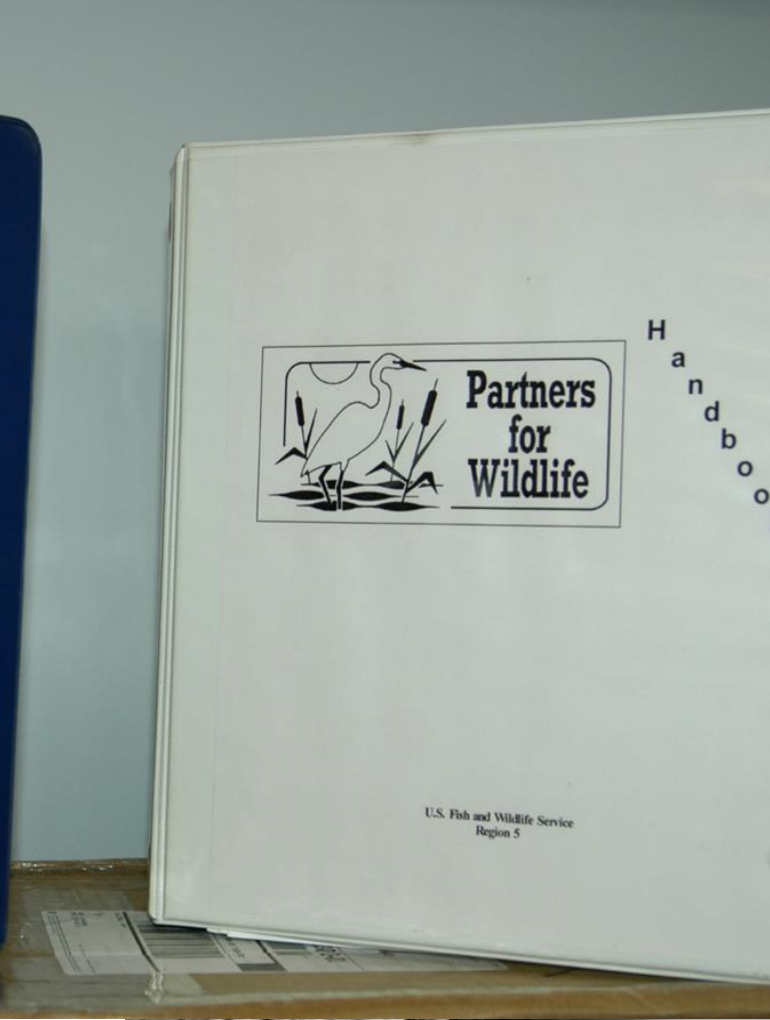

- **Restored >7 million acres of habitat**
- **Partnered with >50,000 landowners**
- **Leveraged funds at a rate better than 4:1**

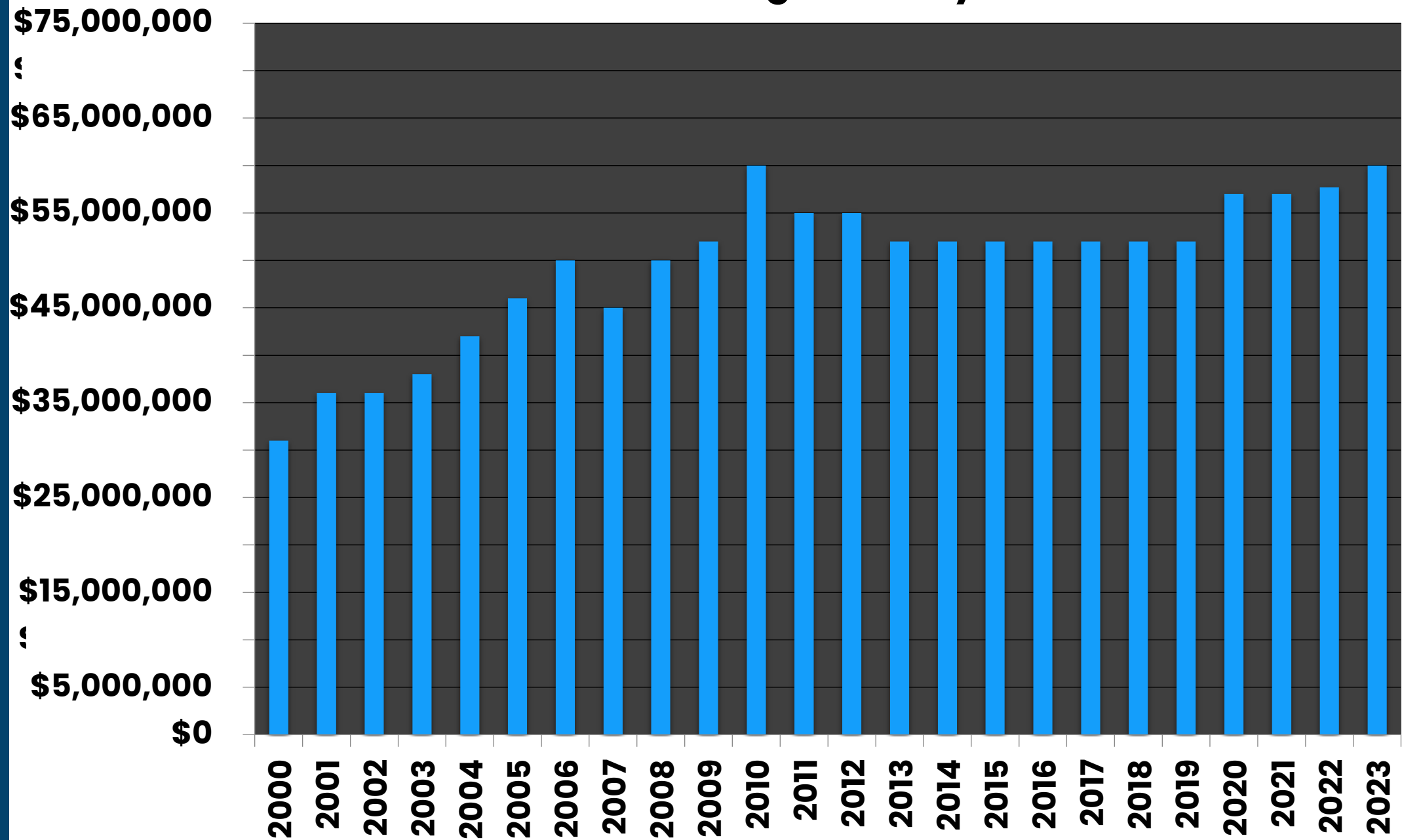

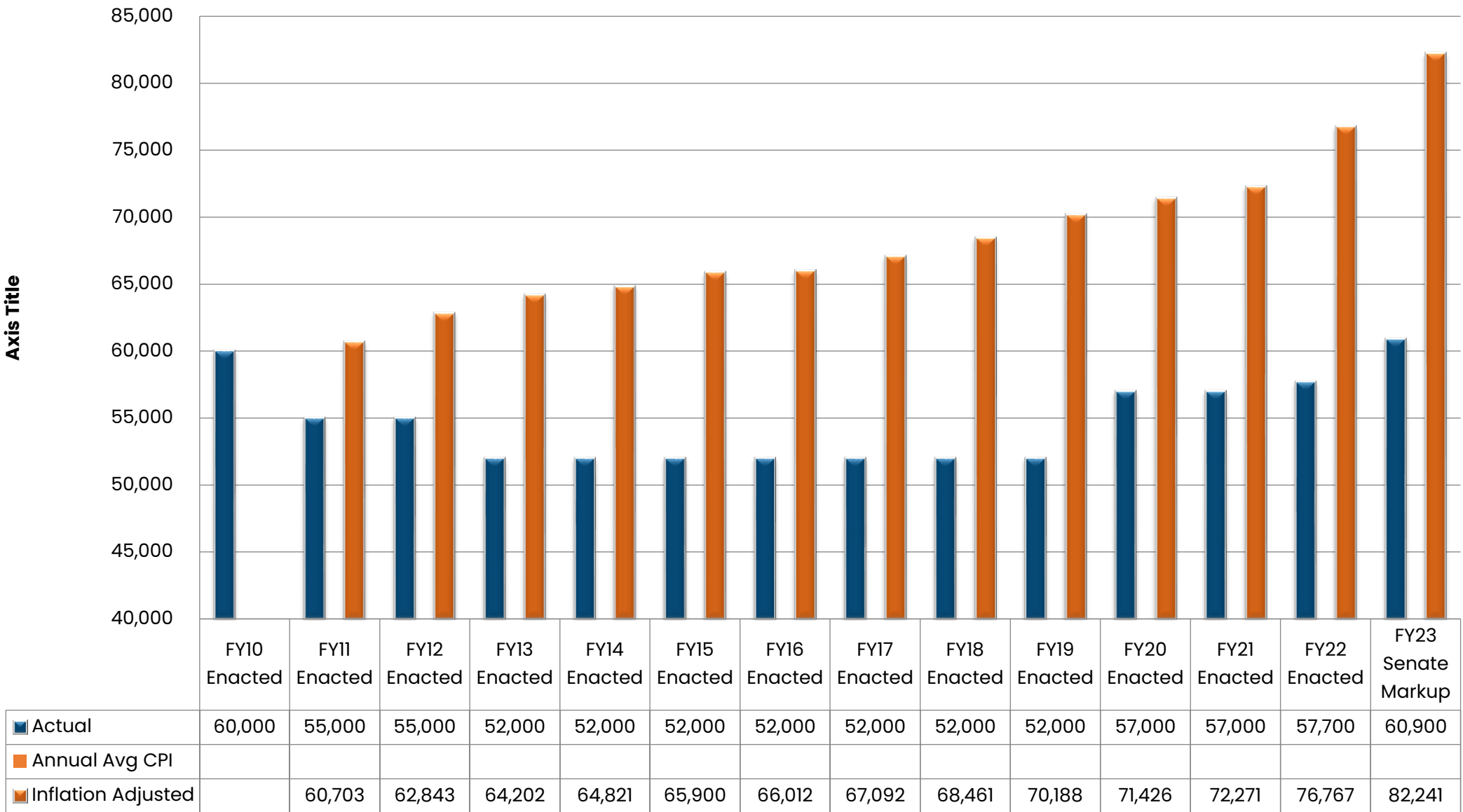

Partners for Fish and Wildlife Act:

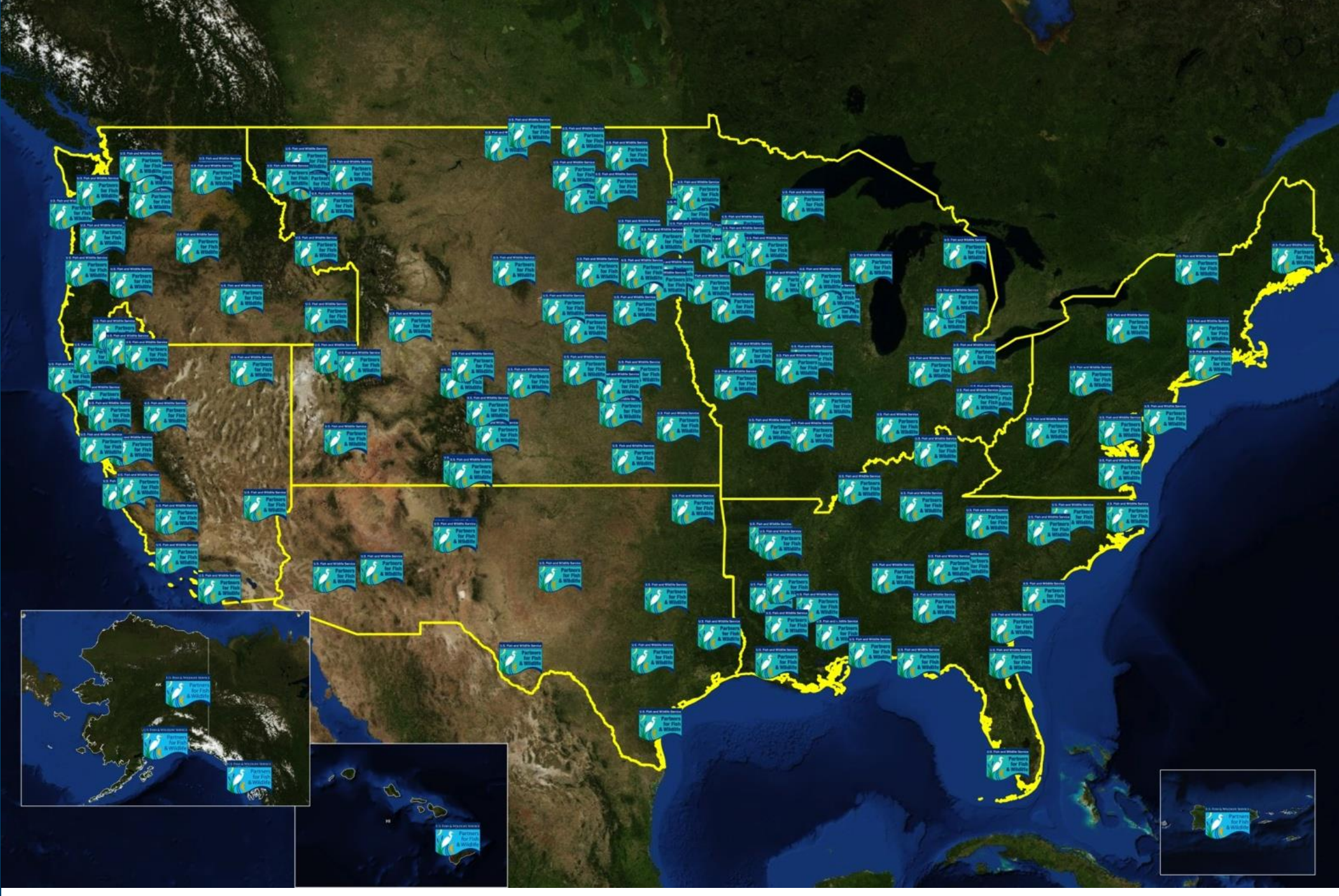
- Reauthorized for \$75M under the Dingell Act

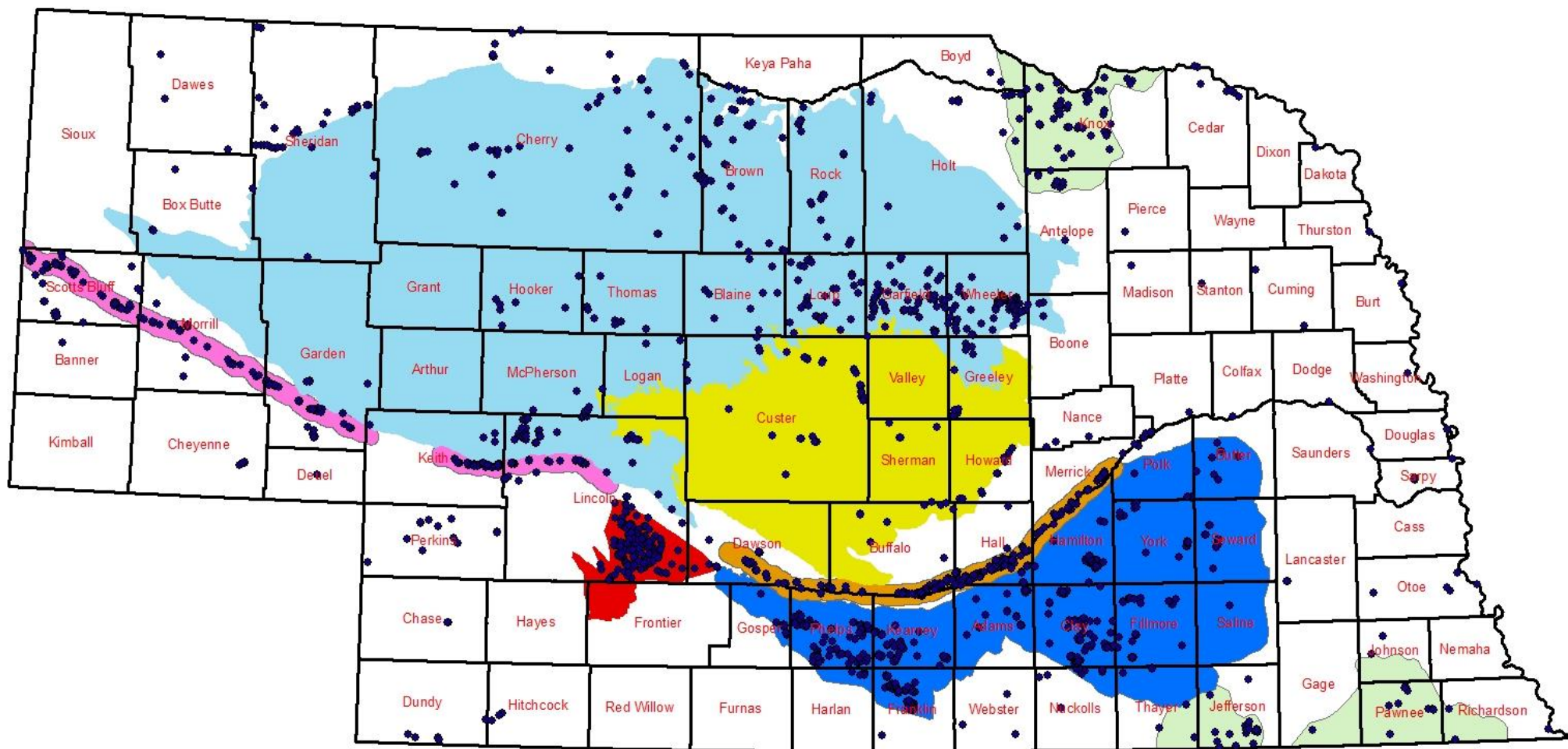

Over 1,650 Landowner Agreements

Approximately 70,300 acres of wetland habitat restored, and/or enhanced.

Approximately 475,000 acres of upland habitat restored and/or enhanced.

Approximately 350 miles of riverine/stream/riparian habitat restored/enhanced.

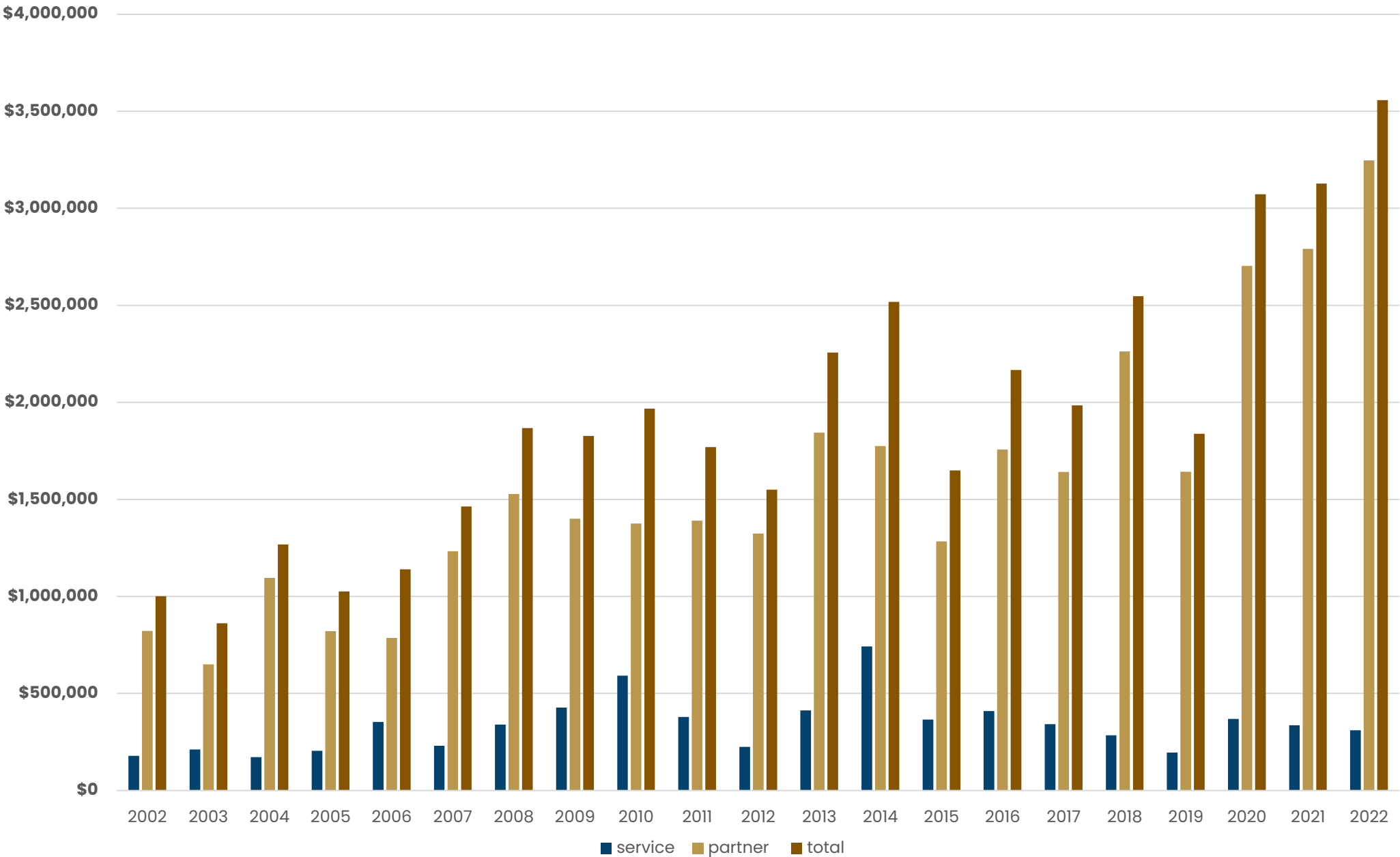
Approximately 180 miles of sloughs, backwaters, and side channels restored.
