






REFUGE SYSTEM






Since 1987, the PFW Program has:

- Completed >60,000 projects in all 50 States & Territories
- Restored >7 million acres of habitat
- Partnered with >50,000 landowners
- Leveraged funds at a rate better than 4:1



Authorizing Legislation & Funding


Partners for Fish and Wildlife Act:

- Reauthorized for \$75M under the Dingell Act
- Appropriated at \$60M- FY 2023







Over 1,650 Landowner Agreements


Approximately 70,300 acres of wetland habitat restored, and/or enhanced.

Approximately <u>350 miles</u> of riverine/stream/riparian habitat restored/enhanced.


Approximately <u>180 miles</u> of sloughs, backwaters, and side channels restored.
