- Directors must have shown desire to educate the general public about NRD activities and conservation efforts.
- Nominee must have demonstrated regular attendance at local NRD board meetings and functions
- One award will be presented each year at the NARD annual conference.

Nominations

- 1. Nominations must include:
 - o Nominee name, address, telephone number
 - o Submitting NRD name, address, and telephone number
- 2. Description of the activities and accomplishements of the nominee.
- 3. Nominations must not exceed <u>two</u> typed, double-spaced pages. Please try and include any supplemental information, e.g. newspaper articles, four photographs, etc.

Procedure

- 1. Qualified nominations must be submitted by a local NRD manager.
- Nominations must be submitted to the NARD office by May 1.
