

2015 NRD Poster Contest

The Nebraska Association of Resources Districts along with Nebraska's Natural Resources Districts provide kindergarten through twelfth grade students with an opportunity to share their thoughts about soil, water and related natural resource issues. It also highlights the educational outreach efforts of conservation districts and their state conservation associations, auxiliaries and/or agencies.

ELIGIBILITY

The NRD Poster Contest is open to kindergarten through twelfth grade students. The local conservation natural resources district-sponsored poster contest will select local winners. The winning posters will get sent to NARD where state winners will be selected. The state winners will then get to compete at a national level. For a full set of rules, go to this link:

One poster from each state may be entered in each of the following grade categories: K-1, 2-3, 4-6, 7-9 and 10-12. The Nebraska Association of Resources Districts will enter posters to NACD. The state does not have to enter a poster for every grade level.

Contest Theme: "Local Heroes - Your Hardworking Pollinators" (with or without a hyphen will be accepted)

Posters must be received by the Nebraska Association of Resources Districts by **Friday, November 20, 2015**.

Poster size: Any size between 8.5" x 11" and 22" x 28" will be accepted.
