Nomination Form: Hall of Fame

The Nebraska Association of Resources Districts (NARD) sponsors the NRD Hall of Fame to recognize outstanding effort and dedication to conservation, resulting in improving natural resources in Nebraska. The purpose for the Hall of Fame is to reward individuals for service and commitment to natural resources conservation. The candidate will be elected into the Hall of Fame by vote of current NRD managers and NARD board members. There are three different as follows:

- NRD Board Member
- NRD Employee
- NRD Supporter – individual outside the NRD system, which could include but is not limited to an agency employee, journalist, politician, community leader, etc.

Criteria

- Current or past board member, employee or individual involved with natural resources conservation for a minimum of 10 years.
- Demonstrate exceptional leadership and dedication to the growth and development of the NRDs.
- Demonstrate innovation and leadership qualities to natural resources conservation at the local, state and/or federal level.
- Easily recognized in the natural resources community, statewide.

Nominations

1. Nominations must include:
 - Nominee name, address, telephone number
 - Submitting NRD name, address, and telephone number
 - Description of activities and accomplishments of the nominee with special notation of years of involvement.
2. Nominations must not exceed **two** typed, double-spaced pages. Please try and include any supplemental information, e.g. newspaper articles, four photographs, etc.

Procedure

1. Nominations must be submitted by a local NRD manager or NARD board member.
2. Nominations must be submitted to the NARD office by May 1.

3. The NARD Executive Committee will serve as the ballot nomination committee and determine the final ballot. The final ballot will be sent out by the NARD to NRD managers and NARD board members to vote for one person in each category on the ballot.
4. The recipient will be recognized at the NARD Annual Fall Conference. The NARD Executive Director or his/her designee will present the award.
