Nomination Form: Outstanding Grassland Conservation Award

The Nebraska Association of Resources Districts (NARD) sponsors an annual Nebraska Outstanding Grassland Conservation Award to:

- Reward outstanding grassland management
- Promote grassland management
- Provide recognition to NRDs and the NARD

Criteria

- Individuals and livestock operations are eligible.
- Recipient of award must be a livestock producer or operation utilizing rangeland (native) and/or pastureland (introduced) resources.
- The basis for selecting the NRD and NARD Outstanding Grassland Conservation Award recipient will be proper management of grassland (rangeland or pastureland) in a manner prescribed to be proper in accordance with capabilities and economics of the land.

Nominations

- 1. Nominations must include:
 - Nominee name, address, telephone number
 - o Submitting NRD name, address, and telephone number
 - Support information including:
 - Background information (vocation, type of business, family involvement, type of livestock, water facilities, increases in carry capacity of the land, management plant, etc.)
 - Rangeland and/or pastureland planting activities (history, purpose of plantings, years of planting, number of acres planted, etc.)
 - Rangeland and/or pastureland maintenance activities (rangeland/pastureland promotion and/or education activities, utilization of rancher's own labor and equipment, miles of cross fencing, number of wells, pasture rotation, planting inter-seeding, etc.)
 - Other conservation activities, tree plantings, awards, etc.

- Nominations must include at least <u>four</u> photographs. You will be asked to obtain a photo of the nominee(s) if they are chosen as the winner.
- 2. Nominations must not exceed <u>two</u> typed, double-spaced pages. Please try and include any supplemental information, e.g. newspaper articles, four photographs, etc.

Procedure

- Nominations must be submitted by a Natural Resources District. Local NRD grassland conservation award recipients or other NRD nomination are eligible. Any individual, organization, or agency is encouraged to submit a nomination to a local NRD. Each NRD may submit only one nomination.
- Nominations must be submitted to the NARD office by May 1. NARD Native Vegetation & Forestry Subcommittee 601 S. 12th St., Ste 201 Lincoln, NE 68508
- 3. The NARD Native Vegetation and Forestry Subcommittee will serve as the selection committee.
- 4. The recipient will be recognized at the NARD Annual Fall Conference. The NARD Executive Director or his/her designee will present the award.
