North Platte NRD Reminds Landowners About Cost-Share Opportunities

The Board of Directors and Staff of the North Platte Natural Resources District

(NPNRD) would like to remind producers and landowners in the District that applications for the

conservation cost-share program will be accepted at your local Natural Resources and

Conservation Service offices until on February 12th. And will be scored on February 15th.

Landowners will be notified by mail as to the status of their application. Applications have been

accepted since February 14th on a continuous basis. The Conservation Cost-Share Program

reimburses cooperating landowners for a portion of the costs of installing conservation practices

on their farm or ranch. The programs are available to landowners in Banner, Garden, Morrill,

Scotts Bluff and southern Sioux counties for soil, water and range conservation improvements.

The District would also like to remind those landowners in the fully appropriated potion of

the District that flow meters are being required on all irrigation wells, and there are cost-share

options available to help with the costs.

Applications will be scored, ranked, and ultimately awarded based on rankings established

by the Board of Directors. The ranking system will allow the cost-share funds to be prioritized

in a way that will help with the District's ground water management goals. Cost-share rates will

change to a uniform 50 percent of actual cost or the cost share docket, whichever is less, with a

maximum amount of \$3,000 per landowner per practice.

Applications received after February 12th will be considered for Fiscal Year 2016. These applications will be accepted on a continuous basis and will be reviewed in February 2017.

Landowners will have until June 1st to complete the project, and extensions will not be granted. Landowners will have to provide bills/cost verifications, pictures, and map of finished practice before the funds will be distributed.
