The run starts at 9:00 AM with a 100 meter Kids Dash following the race.

The Natural Resources Districts are excited to raise money for youth who love the outdoors and are excited to learn how to better conserve Nebraska's natural resources. Each dollar raised goes to several programs the Nebraska Association of Resources Districts (NARD) Foundation sponsors. These include programs like: FFA, a student organization for those interested in agriculture and leadership; The Adventure Camp about the Environment where middle-school aged children learn about the state's wildlife, soil and water; and the Envirothon, a competition for high school students where they can test their knowledge and skills on natural resources management and environmental issues. The Foundation gives more than \$25,000 every year to educating Nebraska's youth about conserving Nebraska's natural resources!

The Natural Resources Districts' run last year in Wahoo was a great success in raising more than \$4,000. This year, Papio-Missouri River Natural Resources District is teaming up with the Nebraska Association of Resources Districts Foundation with a goal to raise even more!

The NRDs plan to move the run to a different NRD recreation area every year, so everyone gets a chance to see our amazing recreation areas, lakes, running and hiking trails, camping, boating and fishing sites across Nebraska!

The state's 23 Natural Resources Districts are proud to protect the lives, property and future of Nebraska. We hope the public comes out to support our youth and spend the morning enjoying Chalco Hills Recreation Area!
