The Nebraska Envirothon is designed for high school students (9-12) to test their knowledge about the environment. Five-member teams participate in regional competitions to demonstrate their knowledge of environmental science and natural resources management on seven topics.

Preparing for Envirothon is easier than you think! Most teachers already teach the tested materials in their classrooms. To provide you with additional help, the Nebraska Association of Resources Districts has online study materials from Nebraska resource professionals and agencies. Testing is offered in six regions.



GET INVOLVED!

This is an excellent opportunity to expose students to environmental careers, and test their knowledge outside the classroom. Envirothon teams have the opportunity to interact with resource professionals working throughout the state. Regional competition winners advance to the state competition hosted at the end of April. The winning state team participates in the National Envirothon in July. Past national competitions:
