Generally, NRD conservation trees and shrubs come as bare root seedlings in bundles of 25.



Why plant trees?

- Windbreaks protect livestock from extreme
 temperatures, reducing stress and mortality.
- 2 Riparian buffers enhance water quality while preventing erosion and sedimentation.
- Windbreaks boost crop yields and minimize soil erosion on agriculture fields.
- Trees and shrubs offer essential habitat, cover, and food for wildlife.
- 5 Windbreaks shield homes and buildings from wind, lowering energy costs.
